## 1. Participants.

The Summer Academy of Early Music invites all enthusiasts of early music – regardless of skill level or age. We encourage both ensembles and individuals to participate – everyone will find something for themselves. Our offer is particularly aimed at:

- singers and instrumentalists,
- lovers of early music,
- those combining study with stage practice.

## 2. Goals.

The Summer Academy of Early Music pursues the following objectives:

- improving the performance level of early music,
- expanding knowledge of historical performance practices,
- developing interpretative awareness in line with tradition,
- refining stage presentation,
- broadening the repertoire in early music,
- deepening analytical skills understanding a piece in the context of its musical structure, textual content, and historical background,
- shaping programming competence creating cohesive concert concepts.

# 3. Workshop Program – Scope of Activities.

The Summer Academy of Early Music includes the following areas of study:

- repertoire and instrument selection in accordance with historical practice,
- the art of interpretation working on stylistically informed performances,
- technical mastery honing performance skills,
- ensemble and individual work building synergy within a musical group,
- stage presentation developing conscious artistic expression,
- soft skills body language, stress management, communication with the ensemble and audience,
- concert presentations realizing projects in various spaces with performance discussions.

#### 4. Requirements and Organizational Recommendations.

4.1. Repertoire Preparation:

- Each participant must prepare 3-5 pieces for workshop work, ready for concert presentation.
- Full metadata of the pieces (composer, title, era) must be submitted with the application.
- 4.2. Performance Requirement:
- At least 2 pieces should be memorized (if technically feasible for the participant).
- 4.3. Recommended Attire:
  - Concert attire for presentations,
  - Comfortable sportswear for workshops.
- 4.4. Registration:
  - Early submission of preliminary participation declarations is recommended to secure a spot.

## 5. Participation Rules and Conditions.

5.1. Workshop Organization:

- Participants must bring their own instruments the Academy does not provide instruments.
- Places are limited priority is given to qualified applicants in order of registration.
- The Academy reserves the right to cancel the event if there are insufficient registrations, with automatic refunds.
- 5.2. Participants:
  - Open to all age groups and skill levels.
  - Both ensembles and individuals may participate (ensembles work in their own formations, individuals in workshop groups).
- Each participant is entitled to individual consultations with instructors.
- 5.3. Registration and Payments:
  - **Preliminary participation declaration** (spot reservation): **by May 15, 2025**.
  - **Full application** (Participation Form + materials from section 4.1.): **by June 25, 2025** send only via email (subject: "Academy '25 [surname/ensemble name]").
  - Participation Form in editable format (doc/odt) and a scan of the signed document (by June 25, 2025).
  - Not accepted: applications in PDF or without required attachments.
  - Participation fee: 600 PLN/person (includes: accommodation, meals, workshops).
  - Payment: to account no. 53 1240 4878 1111 0000 4711 6793 (Bank Pekao SA, Sucha Beskidzka branch)
- with the note "Academy '2025 [full name/ensemble name]".
- Payment deadline: June 30, 2025 (deadline negotiable upon request).
- Lack of payment results in removal from the list.
- Cancellation after the deadline means no refund.

5.4. Additional Provisions:

- Minors: written guardian consent or presence of an adult guardian is required.
- Copyright: The Organizer is not legally responsible for participants' failure to comply with copyright law or legal actions taken by copyright organizations. Participants must handle copyright formalities themselves.
- Image rights: Participation implies consent for recording and publication of image in all media.
- Changes: The Organizer reserves the right to modify rules and program.
- 5.5. Participation Confirmation:
  - Final qualification and participant notification by June 26, 2025.
- Detailed schedule will be sent after the participant list is finalized.
- 5.6. Submission of the Participation Declaration / Participation Form constitutes acknowledgment of these Regulations and commitment to comply.
